

# GUIDANCE ON THE UN SYSTEM-WIDE KNOWLEDGE HUB ON ADDRESSING SEXUAL HARASSMENT

The UN System-wide Knowledge Hub on Addressing Sexual Harassment serves as a central repository for resources, best practices, and tools that support the UN System's efforts to prevent and respond to sexual harassment. The Hub is publicly accessible to all UN personnel, Member States, and Civil Society, and available in all six official UN languages and fully complies with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines.

### **Key Features**

- As of November 2024, the Knowledge Hub hosts over 200 resources from the UN System and UN Member States, and civil society partners, contributing to a shared understanding and collective action against sexual harassment.
- Visitors of the Knowledge Hub can search and download resources.
- The Knowledge Hub receives at a monthly average of 9,600 clicks.


- When submitting your resource please add the following additional details:
